\$800 for “Taking Care of Business: A Financial Course for Women Approaching Retirement.”

Family Enrichment Network (2004, Broome)

\$400 for “Internet Safety Safari”, a program teaching teenage girls how to avoid being victimized via the Internet.

Girl Scouts – Indian Hills Council

\$800 for scholarships, case management and troop membership fees for the Thirteenth Moon Program.
