The Young Professionals Advisory Committee of the Community Foundation for South Central New York, Inc. (YPAC) was established to support, develop, and expand the leadership and professional development of young professionals in our region (Broome, Chenango, Delaware, Otsego and Tioga Counties), and increase their involvement and engagement in the community. The fund is administered through the Community Foundation for South Central NY and decisions are made by a group of young professionals from our 5-county region.

Individuals in our 5-county region may submit an application to support professional development opportunities that will expand their skill set. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.

*Young professionals are defined as individuals under the age of 40 that are interested in developing skills and abilities that will expand their employment opportunities and develop professional skills. Consideration will be given to ALL sectors of the workforce including the trades, those beginning their careers, and those transitioning into the workplace.

Grants will be awarded from \$250 to \$1,000 and can be applied to: conference registration fees, hotels, meals, travel and Continuing Education Credit fees, professional licensing fees.
